For more than five years, much of our alma mater has been hidden from view due to necessary repairs that required scaffolding be raised. In the first instance, emergency repairs involved replacement of parapets on the original u-shaped building which opened in 1927. Within several months following the end of the parapet replacement project, the scaffolding went up again after major leaks were detected behind the brickwork of the older section of the building. The work involved removing the bricks section by section, sealing the source of the leaks, and then reattaching the original bricks. Principal's Message

Greetings to my fellow Minstrels and Raiders,



I hope this message finds you well and your families are healthy and safe. Unfortunately, this message does not come to you from my office at Port Richmond but rather, remotely from my home, as has been the case since March 16th. That being said I would still love to update you on the exciting happenings over the last year at our alma mater. As I stated, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our spring term was cut short and students were required to finish out the year remotely from home doing on-line instruc-

tion. I can't begin to tell you how amazing our staff and students were in making this transition and completing all necessary work and assignments. This was especially hard on our graduating seniors who missed out on many of our traditional senior activities like Senior Night, Senior Awards Night, Senior Prom and graduation at Wagner College. Thankfully, our amazing staff found inventive ways to celebrate our seniors and to make their last few months special. We started off by surprising our 12th graders by delivering 367 lawn signs to their homes during May. We then delivered senior awards and scholarships to each award recipients homes, followed up by a virtual awards ceremony produced by our remarkable TV & Media Arts Academy. We also hung picture of every graduation senior along the fences on Innis Street and St. Joseph's Avenue to proudly honor their accomplishments. Lastly, we ended the year with a "Drive-Thru" Graduation Ceremony around the perimeter of the building with more than 140 staff members lining the streets applauding and recognizing the outstanding class of 2020. On top of all that, I am pleased to share that as of today, it looks like this senior class will have the highest graduation rate we've had in the last decade and I am optimistic that our graduation rate will continue to increase each year of my tenure as principal.

Other exciting happenings this year, was the groundbreaking on our new 17 million dollar athletic complex, a new gymnasium floor, and six brand new state of the art computer labs valued at approximately \$600,000. This year our impressive drama department performed their first Winter Musical "Once on this Island" while our Raiders Abroad program continued for a second year travelling to Japan with thirty of our students during Mid-Winter break.

All year our students continued to amaze and impress me with an outstanding graduating class that amassed a total of nine million dollars in college scholarships. A student body that collected over 50 pints of life saving blood and completed over 10,000 hours of community service.

Lastly, I'd like to thank our amazing alumni association for your devotion to our school, your generosity to our students and your ongoing support of our programs and me as I finish my second year as principal. I wish you all a wonderful summer and I hope we have an opportunity to see each other at all of our exciting events next school year.
